Our mini-debate camp immerses students in the principles of logical argumentation and persuasive writing with an emphasis on critical thinking and analytical skills. Most of all, it will take place in a fun, interactive and confidence-building atmosphere. The camp is designed with educational and engaging partner and group activities such as open brainstorming sessions, live demonstrations, mock cross-examination sessions, and response and counter-response drillings.

Through a carefully selected debate topic of special interest to students in grades 7-9, the students will learn how to:

- Structure their opinions in a well-organized, logical way
- Express their ideas in a cogent, intelligent manner
- Speak and write persuasively
- See issues from different perspectives and recognize complex issues
- Distinguish between logical and illogical arguments
- Learn to think clearly while under time pressure
- Feel comfortable speaking in front of groups and experience the excitement that comes from performing well in front of an audience.

This four-day session culminates in a one-day championship tournament, giving students the opportunity to demonstrate their progress. Finally, a small awards ceremony will recognize the most improved skills of each participant. Limited to six students per session.

She competed extensively in her high school debate and speech programs both locally and nationally and is a recipient of the National Forensic League Degree of Excellence in Lincoln Douglas Debate and the Speech categories of Original Oratory and Extemporaneous Speaking.
